Stars and Guitars Returns June 21



Mark your calendars to join us on Friday, June 21 for Colleyville's annual patriotic celebration. The event features a FREE concert with Rhett Akins

followed by a fireworks celebration for all!

Rhett Akins has had an extremely impressive career. He's not just been a successful solo artist; he's written chart toppers for many artists. Rhett has had 35 No. I singles (and counting). His first No. I hit, "That Ain't My Truck," which he also co-wrote, has since become Rhett's signature song. Some artists who have recorded songs written by Rhett include Luke Bryan, Jason Aldean, Dustin Lynch, Blake Shelton, John Pardi, Parker McCollum, and Thomas Rhett, to name a few.

This impressive list hasn't gone unnoticed in the music industry. In 2010, Rhett was named the No. 4 Billboard Country Songwriter. The following year, BMI named him Songwriter of the Year. He won it again in 2014. His song "Honey Bee" became the highest-selling digital debut by a country male Solo Artist. His biggest accomplishment, though, may be winning the CMA Triple Play award a total of eight times! In April 2018, Rhett was named Songwriter of the Year, and in September 2019 named the first Songwriter of the Decade by the Academy of Country Music. In November 2021, Rhett was inducted into the Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame.

Rhett Akins has already achieved so much as both an artist and a songwriter, but he's not done yet! We are excited to have Rhett for Stars and Guitars. For more information on the event, visit <u>Colleyville.com/stars2024</u>.

Capital Projects Update

The City continues to invest in its infrastructure with several capital projects underway throughout Colleyville. The Quail Crest project in the southeast part of Colleyville includes water and wastewater line upsizing as well as road repairs. The City recently began a much needed drainage improvement to the Pecan Park neighborhood behind Caliber Collision on SH26. The City recently awarded a bid for a project that will increase water pressure in the Preston Manor subdivision, which was experiencing very low pressure. The City also has road resurfacing projects ongoing in partnership with Tarrant County including Cooks Ln, Waller Ln, and several streets within the Tara subdivision. By partnering with Tarrant County, the City saves about 40% per project. The City supplies the materials, and Tarrant County provides the workers and equipment. Finally, the Recreation Center renovation project is well underway that includes a large gymnasium for volleyball and basketball and classroom space for all of the Parks programming. With summer right around the corner, the Fire Department is offering free pool safety assessments to all residents. The department has partnered with Cooks Children's Hospital network to provide life jackets and no cost CPR training. Each year almost 400 kids under 5 years old drown in pools.
