Petitioner further requests that the offense not be shown or made known in any manner for any purpose.

ALCOHOL OFFENSE:

Petitioner is now at least the age of twenty-one (21) years. Petitioner, being duly sworn, states under oath that he/she has not been convicted of any other violation of the Alcoholic Beverage Code while a minor.

Petitioner requests that all records of said offense be expunged pursuant to Section 106.12, ABC and that the Court order expunction of all documents, records, and references thereof and release him/her from all disabilities resulting from said case. Petitioner further requests that said offense not be shown or made known in any manner for any purpose.

TOBACCO OFFENSE: (no age requirement)

Petitioner, being duly sworn, states under oath that he/she has completed an authorized tobacco awareness program.

Petitioner requests that all records of said offense be expunged pursuant to Section 161.255 HSC and that the Court order expunction of all documents, records, and references thereof and release him/her from all disabilities resulting from said case. Petitioner further requests that said offense not be shown or made known in any manner for any purpose.

EDUCATION CODE OFFENSE:

Petitioner is now at least the age seventeen (17) years. Petitioner, being duly sworn, states under oath and he/she has not been convicted of any other Education Code violation.

Petitioner requests that all records of said offense be expunged pursuant to Article 45.055 CCP and that the Court order expunction of all documents, records, and references thereof and release him/her from all disabilities resulting from said case. Petitioner further requests that said offense not be shown or made known in any manner for any purpose.
