CITY OF COLLEYVILLE GA-21 REOPENING GUIDELINES

MAY 7, 2020

EFFECTIVE MONDAY, MAY 1

- o In-store retail operating at 25% occupancy*
- o Dine-in restaurants operating at 25% occupancy*
 - Outdoor patio dining operating at 100% occupancy
- o Movie theaters operating at 25% occupancy*
- o Libraries operating at 25% occupancy*
- o Event venues operating at 25% occupancy*
- o Golf course operations
- o Local government operations
- o All business previously deemed "essential services" remain fully opened

EFFECTIVE FRIDAY, MAY 8

- o Cosmetology salons, hair salons, barber shops, and nail salons may open but should follow guidelines set forth in *The Governor's Report to Open Texas* (*Open Texas*)
 - These services are allowed on a one-on-one basis
 - Interactions require the use of appropriate PPE (i.e. masks) for employees and clients
- o Tanning salons may open but should follow guidelines set forth in Open Texas
- o Indoor or outdoor swimming pools may operate but must follow occupancy levels set forth in *Open Texas*
- o Weddings and funerals taking place in a church shall follow "House of Worship" occupancy guidelines
- o All other events, receptions, or gatherings shall follow 25% occupancy guidelines
 - Occupancy limitations shall not apply to outdoor wedding, funeral, or graduation events

EFFECTIVE MONDAY, MAY 18

- o Gyms and exercise facilities will be able to reopen with 25% capacity
 - Showers and locker rooms must remain closed
 - Disinfection of all equipment after each use is required
- o Services provided in an office may operate with the greater of the following: five employees, or 25% of their workforce, provided that social distancing can be maintained
- o Non-essential manufacturing services may operate at 25% occupancy

REMAINING CLOSED

- o The following businesses should remain closed:
 - Bars and massage services (except for medically prescribed massages)
